

Picture Frame Craft

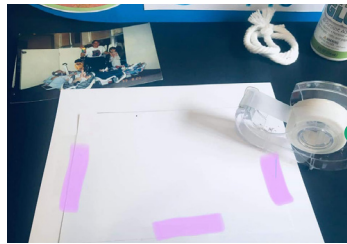
Go through old photos with your family and then create a picture frame for them!

Materials needed:

- Picture
- Construction paper or cardboard
- Glue
- Tape
- Scissors
- Decorations!
We used colorful paperclips, you can use markers, crayons, colored pencils, pom poms, or whatever you would like to decorate the frame with.
- String



Step One: Cut a piece of paper or construction paper into a rectangle, this will be the size of the frame, so make it a few inches bigger than the picture on each side.



Step Two: Cut a rectangle out in the middle of the cardboard. The rectangle size should be slightly smaller than the picture.



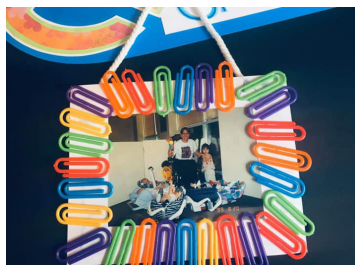
Step Three: Make the back of the frame. Cut a rectangle out of another piece of paper. Make sure this rectangle is slightly smaller than the whole frame, so that it easily covers the center of the frame.



Step Four: Tape this new rectangle to the back of the frame, making sure you leave one side open so you can slide the picture in.



Step Five: Decorate the front of the frame however you would like and attach the string to the back of the frame, so that the frame can be hung up.



Step Six: Slide the picture into the frame. **HAVE FUN!**
